

Bridle Ridge Pool rules:

Pool Use

Use of the pool is for Bridle Ridge residents who have paid their HOA dues. A valid key to the pool gate is required as proof of residency and good standing with HOA requirements. All residents must sign in upon entering the pool area. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Age Requirement

Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Children from 12 to 16 will have to register. Children in this age range will be given their own personal proximity card at a cost of \$10 per child and must have their own personal proximity card with them at all times at the pool. Children from 12 to 16 are not allowed to bring friends to the pool from outside the neighborhood, unless they are accompanied by an adult.

Guests

All guests must be accompanied by a resident over the age of 18. Unless a prearranged party or function, a maximum of 6 guests per household is permitted.

Hourly Adult Swim Time

Once an hour there will be a 15 minute adult swim period, everyone under 18 years of age must be out of the pool. During this time there will be NO LIFEGUARD watching the pool. This time serves several purposes:

1. It allows the adults to swim without interference from playing children.
2. It prevents injury by allowing the Children to recuperate from strenuous activity.
3. Allows the lifeguards the time to police the pool and bathrooms.
4. Gives the lifeguards time to get out of the heat and sun.

There will be no Adult Swim during the last hour the pool is open.

Special Events and Parties

For special pool events/parties, please contact the lifeguard company for rules and fees. Hourly rates apply for additional guards.

No one at any time is permitted in the pool area without a lifeguard.

Anyone in the pool area must obey the lifeguard on duty. The lifeguard has the authority to remove anyone from the pool area whose conduct is deemed unsuitable.

Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted in the pool area without adult supervision.

Children from 12 to 16 will have to register. Children in this age range will be given their own personal proximity card at a cost of \$10 per child and must have their own personal proximity card with them at all times at the pool. Children from 12 to 16 are

not allowed to bring friends to the pool from outside the neighborhood, unless they are accompanied by an adult.

No running in the pool area.

No diving in the shallow end of the pool.

No animals are allowed in the pool area.

No pushing, pulling, or throwing anyone into the pool.

No gum, GLASS, or breakable items are allowed in the pool area.

No Smoking is allowed in the pool area.

The pool chairs shall not be used to build forts.

Bathing suits are Proper attire in the pool. Street clothes are not to be used as a bathing suit.

No climbing on lifeguard stand or sitting in a lifeguard's chair.

The telephone is for emergency use only.

Bicycles, roller blades, Heelies and skateboards are not allowed in the pool area.

Profanity and unnecessary noise are not permitted at any time.

Playing tennis while your children are swimming is not considered adequate supervision.

Any unsupervised children under the age of 12 will be restricted from the water until a parent or an adult returns to pick up the child.

The clubhouse restrooms are off limits to bathers. Restrooms are located in the pool area for your convenience.

Children under the age of 5 should be accompanied to the restroom by a parent or responsible older child so that we can maintain the cleanliness of the bathrooms throughout the day.

Children unable to swim on their own and under 3 feet in height (depth of shallow-end) must wear a flotation device (i.e., swimies or water wings) at all times while inside the pool area. The wading pool is for ages 5 and under ONLY. Parents are responsible for their children in the wading pool at all times.

Children under the age of 4 MUST wear water tight rubber swim diapers while using ANY pool. Lifeguards will monitor the use of the swim diapers. **NO DISPOSABLE SWIMMING DIAPERS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED** without water tight rubber swim diapers. A fine of \$150 may be imposed if an accident occurs that causes the pool to be closed and it is determined the aforementioned rule was violated.

******* Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children at all times.

The Homeowners Association and the lifeguards reserve the right to deny access to the pool to anyone at any time. If rules are violated, the lifeguards will use the following:

1st Offense: Reprimand

2nd Offense: 1 Hour Out of Pool

3rd Offense: 1 Full Day Ejection from Pool

4th Offense: 2 Full Days Ejection from Pool and referral to Pool Committee

Continued or Violent Offenses may result in permanent loss of pool use privileges.
